3. Compliance Information **【Mandatory】**

This daily necessity complies with EU REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006, RoHS 2 (2011/65/EU), and product-specific EU safety standards (e.g., LFGB 80/766/EEC for food contact products, EN 14411 for bath mats/anti-slip products). The product is affixed with the CE conformity marking (where applicable); the full Declaration of Conformity (DoC) and safety test reports are available for download on the manufacturer's official website or upon request from the EU authorized representative.

All materials are free of restricted hazardous substances (lead, mercury, cadmium, BPA, phthalates, etc.); food contact parts adopt food-grade safe materials that meet EU food safety requirements; anti-slip/household use parts comply with EU mechanical safety and environmental protection standards.

NOTE: This product must comply with all applicable safety and regulatory requirements in the market where it is sold. Sellers must confirm the product's material, function and use scenario match local market standards (e.g., food contact certification for kitchen supplies, anti-slip certification for bathroom products).

4. Safety & Warnings **【Mandatory by Category】**

Important Safety Information

Read all use, cleaning and warning instructions carefully before using this product. Keep this manual for future reference and pass it on to any subsequent user. Failure to follow these safety instructions may result in product damage, personal injury (e.g., cuts, slips, choking) or health risks. This product is for household/ daily use only—any improper use, modification or misuse will void the product warranty.

Material & Health Safety Warnings

For food contact products (e.g., water cup, food storage container, cutlery): Do not use with high-temperature oily, acidic or alkaline foods for a long time to avoid material aging or substance migration; do not use in microwave/oven if not marked as microwave-safe.

All products are non-edible; keep small parts (e.g., plastic buckles, rubber gaskets, metal

accessories) out of reach of children under 3 years old to prevent choking or swallowing hazards. Do not use the product if the material is cracked, deformed, discolored or damaged (especially food contact parts)—replace it immediately to avoid health risks.

Do not use abrasive cleaners, steel wool, strong acid/alkali detergents to clean the product, which may scratch the surface or damage the material structure.

Use & Operation Safety Warnings

For anti-slip products (e.g., bath mat, floor mat): Ensure the use surface (bathroom floor, tile) is clean, dry and flat before use; press the mat firmly to exhaust air and ensure full adhesion to prevent slipping and falling.

For hard material products (e.g., stainless steel container, glass cup): Do not drop, collide or knock the product to avoid cracking, deformation or sharp edge damage; do not touch the product with hot hands if used with boiling water to prevent scalds.

For soft material products (e.g., silicone bag, fabric mat): Do not pull, tear or overload the product beyond its bearing capacity (e.g., do not fill heavy objects in small storage bags) to avoid material rupture.

For products with accessories (e.g., lidded container, with handle cup): Check that accessories (lid, handle, buckle) are firmly installed before use; do not use if accessories are loose or damaged to prevent falling or spilling.

Do not use the product for non-intended purposes (e.g., do not use food storage boxes to hold chemicals, do not use bath mats as door mats for outdoor heavy traffic).

Cleaning & Maintenance Warnings

Do not boil the product for a long time (unless marked as high-temperature resistant) to avoid material softening, deformation or aging.

For products with rubber/silicone gaskets: Remove the gaskets for separate cleaning to avoid dirt and mold accumulation in gaps; dry the gaskets completely before reinstallation.

Do not put the product in a dishwasher/sterilizer if not marked as dishwasher-safe — high temperature or strong water pressure may damage the product.

After cleaning, dry the product completely before storage to avoid mold, mildew or rust (for metal parts).

Storage & Transportation Warnings

Store the product in a dry, cool, well-ventilated place (temperature: 0 ° C-40 ° C, humidity: 30%-80%), away from direct sunlight, high temperature (e.g., near heaters, stoves), open fire and corrosive substances.

Do not stack heavy objects on the product to avoid deformation (especially plastic/soft material products); store fragile products (e.g., glass cup) separately with shockproof protection.

For long-term storage, keep the product clean and dry; separate food contact parts from non-food contact items to avoid contamination.

During transportation, fix the product firmly to avoid collision, extrusion or falling; use shockproof and waterproof packaging for fragile or soft material products.

5. Instructions for Use **【Mandatory】**

1. Before First Use

Package Inspection: Open the package and check whether the product and its accessories (if any) are complete and undamaged; if there is missing, cracking, deformation or damage, contact the seller/manufacturer for replacement immediately.

Initial Cleaning: Wash the product thoroughly with mild neutral detergent and clean water (remove all protective films, stickers and packaging residues first); for food contact products, rinse repeatedly with clean water and dry completely before use to remove production-related dust and odor.

Part Check: For products with movable parts/accessories (e.g., buckles, lids, gaskets), check that all parts are flexible and firm; adjust or reinstall loose parts in time.

2. Universal Use Instructions

Basic Use Principles

Use the product in accordance with its marked specifications (e.g., capacity, bearing weight, applicable temperature); do not exceed the rated use range.

For food contact products, ensure the food is at a suitable temperature before placing (follow the product's temperature mark: e.g., $-20^{\circ}\text{C}\sim 100^{\circ}\text{C}$ for silicone food bags); avoid direct contact between hot food and plastic parts for a long time.

For anti-slip products, clean the use surface and product surface before each use to remove dust, oil and water, ensuring the anti-slip function is effective.

Do not place the product in a place where it may be knocked over or touched by children at will (e.g., the edge of a table, the corner of a bathroom).

Product-Specific Use Guidelines

Category 1: Food Contact Daily Necessities (Storage Container/Water Cup/Food Bag)

Fill food/liquid according to the product's capacity scale (do not overfill to avoid spilling when sealing).

For lidded products, press the lid firmly and fasten the buckles (if any) to ensure a tight seal (prevent leakage and food deterioration).

For cold storage/frozen use: Put the sealed product into the refrigerator/freezer directly (comply with the product's low-temperature resistance standard); do not take it out of the freezer and use it immediately at room temperature to avoid condensation or material damage.

For portable use: Check the seal again before carrying; avoid placing it horizontally in a bag for a long time (for liquid-containing products).

Category 2: Bathroom Daily Necessities (Bath Mat/Soap Dish/Toothbrush Holder)

Clean and dry the bathroom floor/tile wall before installation; press the product firmly to exhaust air (for suction cup/anti-slip mat products) to ensure firm adhesion.

Place the product in a non-slip, non-traffic-heavy area (e.g., the inside of the bathtub, the side of the sink); avoid placing it on uneven or rough surfaces.

For soap dishes/toothbrush holders, keep the inside clean and dry to avoid mold and mildew; replace the product in time if the anti-slip/suction cup function fails.

Category 3: Storage & Organization Daily Necessities (Storage Box/Cloth Mat/Organizer)

Classify and place items according to the product's use scenario (e.g., household sundries, office stationery, clothing accessories); do not place sharp, heavy or hard objects that may scratch the product.

For stackable storage boxes, stack them according to the marked stacking limit (do not overstack to avoid collapse and damage).

For fabric/organic material mats/organizers, avoid contact with water, oil and stains for a long time; clean them in time if contaminated.

Category 4: Daily Use Small Items (Non-slip Glove/Kitchen Cloth/Plastic Spoon)

Use the product for its intended purpose only (e.g., non-slip gloves for kitchen operation, kitchen cloth for wiping dry/wet surfaces); do not use for high-temperature or sharp object contact if not marked.

Replace the product in time when it is worn, deformed or loses its original function (e.g., non-slip gloves with reduced friction, kitchen cloth with hardening and mildew).

3. Cleaning & Maintenance

Daily Cleaning: Rinse the product with clean water after use; wipe off stains with a soft clean cloth or sponge (use mild neutral detergent for stubborn stains); rinse thoroughly and dry in a ventilated place.

Deep Cleaning: For products with gaps/gaskets (e.g., lidded containers, silicone bags), remove detachable parts and clean them separately with a small brush; dry all
