

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Before You Begin

- Unpack all components carefully.
- Lay out all hardware and tools on a flat surface.
- Compare parts with the included parts list to ensure everything is complete.
- Recommended tools (varies by product):
 - Phillips screwdriver
 - Flathead screwdriver
 - Allen key (often included)
 - Adjustable wrench
 - Rubber mallet

2. Assembly Steps

Step 1: Prepare the Main Structure

- Identify the primary panels, frame, or base.
- Position them on a clean, flat workspace to prevent scratches.

Step 2: Connect the Base Components

Step 3: Add Functional Components

- Install shelves, handles, attachments, or moving parts.
- Follow the labeled parts (A, B, C...) to ensure correct placement.

Step 4: Secure All Hardware

- Once everything is aligned and level, tighten all screws and bolts firmly.
- Avoid overtightening to prevent damage.

Step 5: Final Inspection

- Check for stability.
- Ensure all moving parts operate smoothly.
- Confirm no parts are loose or misaligned.
